b. COMPULSORY NON-TUITION FEES

- i. Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC): **A\$539** (BUPA) estimate per year for visa duration
- ii. Home stay fees: **\$7,455** per semester (ex GST). (Current for 2017).
- iii. Any other course related fees (see attached)
- iv. Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority fees (*if applicable* Years 11 and 12 students only): **A\$400** per year. (Approx.)
- v. Estimated cost of school uniforms **\$A800** approximately.

c. ESTIMATE of TOTAL COURSE COST: **A\$137,240** for Years 7 to 10 and **A\$70,620** for Years 11 and 12 (excluding other course related fees).

All costs are quoted in Australian Dollars and are correct at the time of publication and are subject to annual review. In addition, students attending other nearby Colleges for Asian language lessons, are required to pay the direct costs of attendance. Indicatively, in one year, these costs are less than A\$2000 per subject, however the amount payable is determined by the respective College.

Fee Payment Arrangements:

- 1) For continuing students, fees for the semester are payable within the first four weeks of each semester.
- 2) For new students, there is a two stream process:
 - a) Applications processed via our Consortium partners, are processed via the relevant partnering organisation.
 - b) Applications processed via Mary MacKillop College: First semester of attendance fees are payable prior to commencement at the College and are part of the visa requirements.
